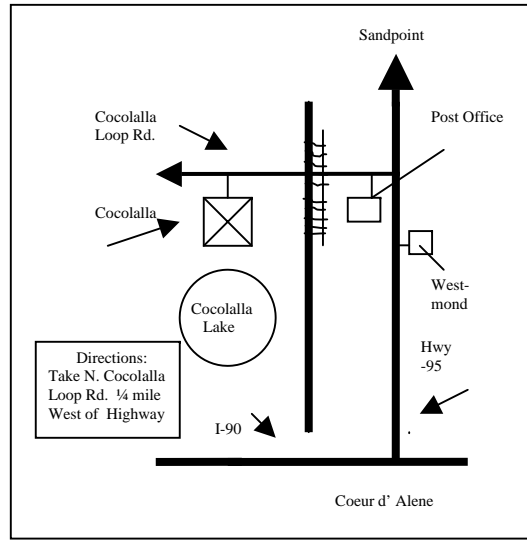

**DIRECTIONS**

Head north on Hwy. 95 for approx. 30-40 minutes (toward Sandpoint) and turn left on Cocolalla Loop Rd. Follow directions on map above.

**From Spokane:**

Head east on I-90, take exit 12 (Wild Waters Exit). Turn left at light and head north on Hwy. 95 (toward Sandpoint) for approx. 30-40 minutes. Turn left on Cocolalla Loop Rd.

##### **Table Runner Placemats (4)**

<b>Fabric A</b>	fat quarter	fat quarter
<b>Fabric B</b>	1/4 yard	1/2 yard
<b>Fabric C</b>	3/4 yard	1 yard
<b>Backing</b>	1/2 yard	1 1/2 yard

**pins**  
**thread**

#### **ADVANCED:**

Please bring for the **Aussie Millwheel Quilt and/or Wall hanging** (looks complicated, but it's deceptively easy. You'll see pinwheels and kaleidoscopes but none to sew.)

**Materials Needed:** You will need two fabrics – one large scale floral (not directional) and one that is neutral – think tone on tone for a good contrast.

##### **Quilt**

1 3/4 yard each

##### **Wall hanging**

1 yard each

If you want to get a head start on the project, cut your fabric into 5 - 10" strips and from the strips cut 18 - 10" squares for the quilt **OR** cut strips into 8 - 10" squares for a total of 16 squares, 8 of each color.

#### **Other needed items:**

Rotary cutting equipment  
a 10" or larger SQUARE ruler or template  
Scotch tape  
Thread
